SAFETY AWARD REWARDED BY TOTAL E&P ITALY



Last April, Total E&P Italy, as part of the construction work continuing at the new Tempa Rossa platform, decided to reward deserving workers and companies who had proved themselves able to conduct their operations on the site without any injury and had therefore contributed through their attention to detail and experience to making the work place as safe as possible.

For this reason MARRAFFA, considered the most deserving subcontractor, and Martino Bufano, our specialized crane operator who has personally handled more than 100 lifts on site, were rewarded with two "Safety Awards", making us extremely proud and highlighting the importance of a complicated job which is very often underestimated. These awards also show how successful a job can be when proper teamwork comes together.

You can never put your feet up and take a rest.. Every 20 years the company is bowled over by a revolution that takes another 20 years to accomplish in full: it first happened with MARRAFFA and then 20 years later with VENPASUD. Our headquarters in Martina Franca (TA), was first followed by a branch in Bari – Modugno, a strategic point that connects the south to north of Italy. This was later followed by a logistics site in Taranto in order to better our ever-increasing fleet of vehicles. This year has marked another revolution for the company with the opening of our new branch in Marghera and the birth of our WERENT brand marking a turning point for the companies in our Group. Enrico Piovan and Andrea Piovan are the first two new employees in this new branch office, located in the centre of the industrialized zone of the port of Venice. Andrea is 31 and works in the rental department, whereas his cousin, 35-year-old Enrico, deals with the abnormal load and lifting department. They have both worked for many years in the field of transportation and rentals. Marghera is a strategic logistics hub, as they well know and they also understand how important it is to reinforce the connections between the south and the north of Italy. However, Marghera is also an important logistic hub just one step from the heart of Europe and allows us to be as close as possible to our customers abroad. Enrico and Andrea carry out their work side by side with the central office in Martina Franca, and in synergy with our site in Bari. Being Angelo's son did not make things any easier for Diego, he has had to work his way up the ladder in the company and find his own way to shine. Today he deals with abnormal loads, from receipt of the order to the preparation of the transport itself, making sure that every authorization and permit that is needed is acquired, he

handles the necessary safety cars and manages customer relations.

Diego's job consists of a series of complex tasks and requires a great degree of responsibility, skills which are also important in VENPASUD, especially now that the company handles transports almost everywhere; Spain, the U.K., Sweden, Norway, Germany, Romania and the Netherlands, are just some of the countries in which MARRAFFA has worked in the last few months. Before even reaching the road, every transport needs to be carefully organized, the route and the itinerary have to be planned, taking into consideration every possible risk and preparing any necessary permits, even when the transportation has to be carried out using the "motorways of the sea". The more complex the transport, the greater the satisfaction when we get the job done, because for MARRAFFA no transport is impossible, as long as the skills of every member of the team are exploited to the full, like in a perfectly oiled mechanism, where everyone knows what to do, how to do it and when. Perfect, just like Diego's diary which is always well-organized and precise, kept almost obsessively neat and tidy to such a point that you get the desire to doodle all over it!

REACHING FOR THE SKIES A CHALLENGING LIFT WHICH NO ONE ELSE THOUGHT WAS POSSIBLE



During the past year (2016) MARRAFFA planned and carried out the vertical placement for a refinery flare stack at the Tempa Rossa site in the region of Basilicata.

The planning behind installing this "Flare" at Tempa Rossa was a real challenge, as everyone thought it was impossible to lift and move certain structures with a fixed crane due to the extremely narrow room to manoeuvre. Project Manager Mauro Massaro, with the help of his team found the only possible placement, calculated to the nearest centimetre, that would allow the correct move sequence and placement of the six main modules, prefabricated on the ground.

It took almost 40 days and months of detailed planning in order to perform all of the critical lifting operations for the six pre-assembled modules on the ground and numerous "raisers" (heat conduction tubes).

With help provided by the VENPASUD vehicle fleet and thanks to the contribution of our technical teams, we were able to achieve lifts with numbers that would seem to defy logic. The maximum lift was for a module weighing 90 tons at a height of 64 metres with a radius of 54 metres. The final, fully-assembled "Flare" had a height of 136 metres and some of the lifts were carried out at a distance of 72 metres.

The main structure was assembled in record time in only 40 days, in full compliance with the strictest safety parameters imposed by TMC and Total, and without compromising any other construction activity being carried out onsite.

Every single critical concern was addressed, including those related to the wind conditions over a height of 80 metres, since at a certain height unexpected gust of wind were quite frequent. In order to be keep conditions as safe as possible it was decided that the work would be stopped if ground-level wind speeds exceeded 5 m/sec. Every lifting operation was overseen by 8-man teams from MARRAFFA (6 operators + 2 supervisors), and 7 assembly operators + 6 supervisors from Tecnimont-Total.

The following vehicles were used:



Terex Demag TC 2800 – 600-ton nominal capacity Crane set up with a 90-metre base boom + a trellis of 72 metres. Tadano Faun ATF 400-G – 400-ton nominal capacity Tadano Faun ATF 100-5 – 100-ton nominal capacity Tadano Faun ATF 70 – 70-ton nominal capacity Wumag 1000 – 103-metre platform from Venpa Sud Srl

HE WHO SOWS WIND, REAPS...ENERGY THE STOMA GROUP EXPERIENCE WITH RENEWABLE ENERGY

Entirely designed and manufactured at the Massafra plant, the 60, 100 and 200 kW wind turbine generators built by STOMA offer the best technology available today in the wind power industry.

Their design characteristics make these generators particularly productive for sites with a medium to low level of wind, but with high turbulence.

The main structural components of all STOMA wind turbine generators are the large diameter three-bladed rotors which are able to ensure the production of electricity even with a 2.5 m/s wind speed and nominal power is achieved with a wind speed of 9.0 m/s (60 kW), 9.6 m/s (100 kW) and 9.4 m/s (200 kW). The aerodynamic nature of the rotors, composed of highly efficient blades with a reduced dimension support footprint, ensure low levels of noise when operating. Right from the start of production of the Stoma wind turbines, MARRAFFA and VENPASUD have played an important role in facilitating the transportation and assembly at height of the towers, the blades and the basket, thereby accompanying the growth of the Stoma wind generator family.





Stoma's mission is based on the costumer satisfaction, by providing them with highly

technological machineries and great production capacity/efficiency.

For this reason we rely on qualified and competent suppliers such as Marraffa srl and Venpasud srl, especially when assembling overhead in arduous conditions.
